Taste the "Supertuscans"

Rally will start in the perfect destination for wine lovers, where vines have been cultivated since the time of the Etruscans, driving in search of memorable tastings and historic cellars, where the famous Sassicaia wine, the "Super Tuscan", was born, and the attractions of the area, such as the **Bolgheri** Castle, and the Viale dei Cipressi, national monument.

Meet the "Italian Cowboys"

Discover the Italian Cowboys, I "Butteri" the cattle breeders and horsemen of the Maremma. whose lifestyle dates back to the spread of agriculture during Etruscan times, and is today struggling to survive.

Farnese Palaces and Land of Popes

Discover **Viterbo** the largest medieval historical center in Europe, surrounded by walls and ancient gates known as the **City of the Popes**, papal seat in the 13th century where for 24 years the Papal Palace hosted and saw the election of several Popes, and the spectacular **Farnesi Palaces** in **Caprarola** and **Bagnaia**

Lorenzo Lotto's 16th century masterpieces

An itinerary to discover museums and art galleries, churches and parish churches in Recanati, Cingoli and Jesi which house the works of Vincenzo Lotto, a painter born in Venice and an original exponent of the Italian Renaissance, who left a large part of his extraordinary works in the Marche.

Welcome to the Accordion's world

In the town of **Castelfidardo**, the world centre of accordion manufacturing, with an ancient history of tradition and craftsmanship, we will visit the historic Paolo Soprani palace, where the first accordion in the world was built in 1863, to whose sound we will dance the popular dances of the "Salterello".

The land of "100 Teathres"

A journey to discover the historic theatres, cultural institutes, theatrical, musical and dance performances in the Marche region, the land of 100 theatres, designed by illustrious architects, such as Giuseppe Piermarini (1734 - 1809), author of the Teatro alla Scala in Milan, author of the Teatro Piermarini in Matelica



ITALY COAST TO COAST

Driving across the Italian Peninsula





Following part of the Via Cassia, traveled in the Middle Ages by pilgrims of the Via Francigena, passing through the Volsini and Cimini mountains, we will cross the territory of Tuscia, of ancient Etruscan origin, admiring astonishing examples of the signs of the temporal power of greedy popes and wine-loving prelates, such as the Gothic Palazzo dei Papi in Viterbo which in 1200 hosted the election of Pope Gregory X.

From Acquapendente to Caprarola dominated by the imposing Palazzo Farnese with its frescoed interiors, the magnificent helicoidal staircase and the Sala del Mappamondo with its maps depicting the then known world.





Leaving the West coast we will cross the green heart of Italy, through the valley of the Nera river to reach **Spoleto** "the city of two worlds", and then climb the peaks of the **Sibillini Mountains**, to reach **Norcia**, with its glorious past full of art, history and spirituality, the birthplace of San Benedetto, and **Le Marche** region, with it's great variety of landscapes and an infinite range of colours that make the area's natural beauty incomparable, plus an artistic heritage that fears no comparison.

Staying in a resort surrounded by nature, we will reach Macerata, Camerino, the gentle hills of Jesi, home of the "Verdicchio" wine, the splendid Furlo Gorge, and some villages rich in history and cultural heritage.





Bolgheri & Suvereto

The small medieval gem surrounded bγ picturesque vineyards that given rise to the "SuperTuscans", famous red wines that are among the most highly esteemed in the world. The itinerary will bring us to Suvereto and Populonia, with a journey through history and beauty. Here Etruscan and Roman ruins lie beside the medieval fortifications. verdant promontory overlooking the sea.

Civita di Bagnoregio

On the Road

Maremma & Tuscia

A fairy-tale village perched on a tufa hill that can only be reached over a long pedestrian bridge, appearing almost looks like a mirage, with its splendid panorama of the Valle dei Calanchi, a constantly changing landscape



The so called "Little Jerusalem": houses grafted overhanging the edge of the tuffaceous boulder dotted with cavities, with the grandiose arches that hold the aqueduct designed in 1293 under the lordship of the Orsini noble family. The Orsini Palace and the Jewish Ghetto and Synagogue of 1598, are memories of how the Jewish community was flourishing.

Wild Tuscany

Maremma is the most authentic and genuine part of Tuscany. With its vastness morphological diversity, it offers beautiful beaches, breathtaking hills up to the Monte Amiata Volcano, it is the home of many fine wines, and is still linked to peasant traditions, such as that Butteri. the the ltalian Cowboys. The traces of the ancient Etruscans, in the Tuscia area, reach up to Lazio, in Viterbo, the ancient city of the Popes.



Bagnaia and Caprarola

Bagnaia with the magnificent Villa Lante with its Italian-style gardens, and the medieval Caprarola with its impressive 16th century Palazzo Farnese, to the abandoned villages of Celleno



The City of Popes, where traces of the Etruscan civilization merge with Mediaeval architecture and beneficial spa waters, to admire the majestic Palazzo dei Papi and the San Pellegrino quarter, the Romanesque Cathedral of San Lorenzo, the Governor's Palace and the Palace of the Podestà.



Umbria & Le Marche On the Road



Home to the Pozzo di San Patrizio, a masterpiece of engineering with a double helical ramp that descends 54 meters underground, and the chair of Thomas Aquinas. The Palazzo del Capitano del Popolo, one of the most beautiful buildings in Orvieto, on the square of the same name, flanks the magnificent Duomo, an extraordinary synthesis of architecture, sculpture,

of architecture, sculpture, decorative arts and painting, considered a jewel of the Italian Romanesque-Gothic style.



Spoleto

Spoleto is among the cities that are symbols of international culture, extraordinarily rich in art from every era and protagonist of prestigious events, such as the Festival dei Due Mondi. Its 80-meter-high Ponte delle Torri, an aqueduct built in the 14th century, connects the Rocca Albornoziana to the slopes of Monteluco





Macerata is famous for its theaters, which crown Piazza della Libertà such as the Teatro Lauro Rossi, built in the eighteenth century in late Baroque style. Palazzo Buonaccorsi houses three collections such as the Carriage Museum, the Ancient Art section with the prestigious Eneide Gallery, and the Modern Art collection

Le Marche

Incredibly "still" unspoilt and full of classic Italian charm and culture, Le Marche has over 180 km of coastline, and 26 medieval cities facing the warm, turquoise Adriatic sea. Born in the times of the Holy Roman Empire, in 800 AD, when the Emperor Charlemagne divided the Empire's possessions into fiefdoms, entrusted to noble marquises, called "mark", or "border", the region preserves an incredible variety of landscapes, small villages and architectural treasures, including the spectacular 100 small municipal theatres.



The medieval village develops on a long and narrow sandstone ridge, and preserves the Town Hall with the Art Gallery and the Accademia Georgica. At the foot of the hill stands the harmonious and solemn Sanctuary of the Holy Crucifix, in the green of the countryside





Founded by the Romans in 247 or 232 BC, on the left hill of the Esino river, it is famous for its vineyard-covered hills where Verdicchio is born, but also for its Pergolesi Theatre, the Renaissance Palazzo della Signoria, and the works of the Venetian painter Lorenzo Lotto created for the Churches of S. Floriano and S. Francesco al Monte, absolute masterpieces of art and spirituality.
